The Delaware County Jail is presenting this guide to prepare you for your commitment into the jail. A jail handbook with a complete list of jail rules will be given to you when you are processed.

Only the following personal items will be permitted:

- 3 pairs of white underwear in the original, unopened package
- 3 white tee shirts in the original, unopened package
- 3 pairs of white socks in the original, unopened package
- 2 white non under wire bras in the original, unopened package
- Soft cover Bible
- Soft cover AA material
- Eyeglasses, contacts and contact solution in the original, unopened package
- Money for commissary
- Prescriptions in the original container
- Medical insurance cards

Contact the Sheriff's Correctional Facility medical section if you are on prescribed medication. Their phone number is 740-833-2847 and the staff can be reached Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. You will need to provide the staff with your name, medication you are taking and length of your commitment.

Your family and friends may schedule a visitation by calling 740-833-2851. Appointments for visitations can **ONLY be scheduled by calling this number Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** Names, addresses, phone numbers and social security numbers of all visitors must be provided when scheduling an appointment. Identification must be provided at the visit. Visitation dates and times vary depending on your housing unit assignment. Once a week you will be allowed a 30 minute visit. Your visitors may consist of 2 adults and up to 4 children. Clergy and attorney visits are unrestricted.

- The United States Postal Service delivers and picks up mail once a day, Monday through Friday
- Money orders will be accepted through the mail. We will **NOT** accept personal checks
- A kiosk is located in the jail lobby for family members to deposit cash into inmate's commissary accounts
- No parcels will be accepted through the mail
- Family members may drop off medication and/or medical supplies only
- The jail does not accept donations.
