Citizens Sheriff Academy



PURPOSE:

The Citizens Sheriff Academy (CSA) of Delaware County, Ohio, is designed to strengthen community relationships through education, shadowing, and hands-on learning. Citizens will not be certified or authorized to perform any law enforcement services. Upon graduation, participants can participate in the CSA Alumni group, where members can choose to serve as volunteers at various Sheriff's Office community events on an as-needed basis (i.e.: Delaware County Fair Sheriff's Educational Cabin).

DURATION:

The nine-week program is offered twice a year: Winter (Jan - Mar) and Fall (Sept - Nov). All classes are taught by law enforcement professionals and are held weekly on Tuesdays, 6:00-8:30pm. Locations will vary but our home base will be at the law enforcement training center at the Delaware Area Career Center, south campus on Columbus Pike/US 23. Upon acceptance into the program, you will receive the class syllabus, which will include all sessions' dates, times, and locations. *NOTE: persons seeking employment as a deputy are not eligible to apply/participate.*

ATTENDANCE:

Participants must attend at least 6 classes in order to graduate.

APPLICATION:

All participants will complete and submit the two-page application by deadline. The application is available through the Sheriff's Office website (delawarecountysheriff.com) about 45 days prior to each session's first class. Applicants will undergo a basic background check and are asked to provide two references. Class will be limited to 15 participants to ensure quality programming and participation.
